DOWNLOAD INSTRUCTIONS

Option 1 | To Listen to a Podcast on-line by Streaming:

Go to the Podcast Site Blog Page and view the listing of sermons.

Find the Sermon you want and **left click** on the *file name* along side "Direct Dowload".

This will download and stream the sermon to your computer and play using your media player.

All sermon files are in *.mp3* format and usual large, so it will take time for the download to complete.

Be patient and don't interrupt the streaming.

Fast adsl broadband is essential for this process.

Option 2 | To Download a Podcast and Save on your Computer:

Go to the Podcast Site Blog Page and view the listing of sermons.

Find the Sermon you want and **right click** on the *file name* along side "Direct Dowload".

This will open a dialogue box. Select "**Save Target as..**" and **left click**.

A dialogue box will open asking for save location.

Select desktop or some other easy to remember location and **press Save**.

Once the file has completely downloaded, locate and play it on your computer's media player.

All **sermon files are in mp3 format** and large, so it will take time for the download to complete.

Be patient and don't interrupt.

Fast adsl broadband is essential for this process.

Option 3 | To Burn a Podcast to a CD for playing in a Home or Car CD Player:

Follow the instructions in *Option 2* above.

Then open your Windows Media Player or Nero or similar burning software.

Select the BURN CD option from the menu and locate your file.

In most cases, the software will convert the *.mp3* file to a normal CD file as it burns (*.cda format*)

This shows up as a 44byte file on your CD. Check your software Options settings.

Note that some car players can handle mp3 files and you can then just *copy or burn* them to a CD as an *.mp3* file according to your media software options.

With *.mp3* files, you can get more on a CD; with a *.cda* file you will usually fit only one sermon.
