1	Have you ever committed a crime ? 	a) No, I have never committed a crime . b) Yes, I have committed a crime . Here are the court records.
2	What does “ crime ” mean?	“ Crime ” means to break a law.
3	Have you ever been arrested ? 	a) No, I have never been arrested. b) Yes, I have been arrested. Here are the court records.
4	What does “ arrested ” mean?	“ Arrested ” means that the police say that you have broken the law and must go to jail.
5	What is a jail or prison ?	You go to jail or prison when you break the law. You cannot leave until a judge says that you can be free.
6	Have you ever been a habitual drunkard ? 	No, I have never been a habitual drunkard .
7	What is a habitual drunkard ?	A habitual drunkard drinks too much alcohol everyday and gets sick.
8	Have you ever been a prostitute ?	No, I have never been a prostitute .
9	What is a prostitute ?	A prostitute sells sex.
10	Have you ever sold or smuggled illegal drugs, or narcotics ?	No, I have never sold or smuggle controlled substances, illegal drugs, or narcotics .
11	What are illegal drugs ? 	Illegal drugs are drugs against the law such as heroin, opium, and cocaine.
12	Have you ever been married to more than 1 person at the same time?	No, I have never been married to more than one person at a single time.
13	Have you ever helped anyone enter the U.S. illegally ?	No, I never helped anyone enter the U.S. illegally .
14	Have you ever gambled illegally ?	No, I have never gambled illegally .
15	What is gambling ? 	Gambling is to play cards or games for money. It is legal to gamble and pay taxes on the money you win. It is illegal to gamble and not pay taxes.
16	Have you ever lied to the US government?	No, I have never lied to the U.S. government.
